Wow - Thanks to the incredible support from our community, partners, donors, volunteers, families and kids, 2021 was one of the best years we've had in Clarks Cove.

Our Summer Youth Sailing Program was back to pre-pandemic numbers, while safely continuing practicing social distancing, keeping the kids in pods and masking when in close proximity.

Our year-round school programming was able to ramp back up and our impact was felt in the New Bedford public school system, as well as the many partner schools and organizations we work with. One, is the Harbor House Family Center, a homeless shelter in New Bedford.

As you can imagine, for the Harbor House families, transportation to and from CBC can be challenging. To that end we have provided, as needed, rides to CBC. One one of the rides back to the shelter, we had one of the children look at a staff member, with a lip quiver and tears streaming down his face, proclaiming, "I don't want to leave. I am so happy here, I want to stay forever."

EDUCATION

CBC's vision is to engage local area youth in learning positive and practical life skills that will allow them to steer toward a successful future, in college, the workforce or as leaders in their community. CBC's long-term vision is to reach all students in the New Bedford school system at least once during their K-12 years. During the Fall, Spring, and Winter, we partner with greater New Bedford organizations to offer STEM education and enrichment opportunities centered around the marine environment for local youth, such as: boat building, ocean stewardship, STEM education and a Marine Trades Training Program.



Spring, Fall and Winter Programming:

During the spring, fall and winter we were thrilled to be back in person with a number of Greater New Bedford partner schools and organizations to offer a number of different programming. We were back in person with our Sisters' School, Nativity Preparatory School, New Bedford Public Schools and Anchor Academy (to name a few). Teaching STEM, building model boats, rowing, sailing and more.



Sea Lab:

CBC has been affiliated with the Sea Lab program for the last twenty years. In 2016, we began teaching an ocean stewardship lesson at Sea Lab where students learn about earth science, boat construction and hydrodynamics. From September to June, CBC works with schools from around the city, reaching every fifth grade student who is part of the New Bedford Public School System. In 2021 we impacted 1400 students through our Sea Lab programming.



Skateboard Building:

In 2021 we introduced Skateboard building to our programming. This program is an extension of our boatbuilding programs and provides an introduction to some elements and tools of woodworking, as well as the modern composite methods of vacuum bagging and molding complex shapes to create a remarkably strong and flexible laminate. The program also incorporates an art project and taps into self-expression and creativity. The 7-layer Maple decks are an eco-friendly means of transportation and are built cleanly, with water soluble glue, paint and varnish.

Junior Instructor Program (JI's):

Our workforce youth development program, built in 2015 in response to economic challenges youth in the city of New Bedford faces, provides jobs to youth aged 14-24. CBC's goal is to mentor all youth from the first time they enter a program until they graduate high school and beyond. Studies have shown that youth with mentors are more likely to graduate from high school, participate in extracurricular activities, and become civically engaged. Our JI's become part of our family. For 2021 we employed 41 JI's.

SUMMER PROGRAMMING:

Our summer program is open to any child, ages 5-17. The program is accessible to all regardless of means. While the majority of our students come from New Bedford, we have participants from many surrounding towns, and even beyond, particularly during the summer when they are visiting family locally. In 2021 68% of our students received financial aid. Each time CBC students step into a boat they are learning a meaningful lesson. Sailing encourages individuals to come together as a team and collectively overcome challenges. CBC's Summer Youth Sailing program is designed to instill positive life values, such as trust, integrity, sound judgment, and teamwork.



SEA SQUIRTS:

5-6 year olds. This program gets them comfortable and familiar with the water. Each day, the kids were read a Dr. Seuss book and then had a lesson for the day based on the messaging from the book.



WINDSURFING:

9-17 year olds. This was the third year of this program and is for anyone wanting to learn how to windsurf. For the first time in 2021 some kids from our windsurfing program traveled to Martha's Vineyard and Florida for windsurfing events.



SUMMER YOUTH SAILING:

7-17 year olds. This program is for someone new to sailing or who has had a few years of sailing experience. The goal being to have fun on the water and to learn the basics of sailing. Kids can be in a boat with others or sail on their own.

WHY HANNA IS A GREAT MENTOR:

Hanna is always ready to help and make a difference. She is an independent thinker who is always willing to be part of a team.

Hanna Hausladen joined the CBC team in 2014. She is a Senior at Colby College, majoring in cellular biology. Hanna will be attending Dental School after she graduates. Hanna was a pivotal instructor this summer, helping run everything from the Sea Squirt's adventures on Damfino to all of the field trips that CBC hosted.

"My favorite sailing memory is when I was a JI, I was with an advanced sailors' class, and it was blowing 15-20kts. My 420 had just entered Clark's Cove, and we were luffing, waiting for the others to catch up, when we saw a dark shape bobbing in the water. We got a bit closer, and it was a seal! It swam around our boat, looking at us curiously, before it swam away."

COMMUNITY AWARD

The CBC Community Award is awarded to a sailing instructor who demonstrates outstanding qualities of vigor, enthusiasm, and spirit throughout the Junior Program.



WHY SUMMER IS A GREAT MENTOR:

Summer is the epitome of a can-do attitude. Even though Summer is a younger instructor, she is one of our most capable mentors – someone who is extremely reliable, committed, and always willing to be silly with the kids.

Summer Daniels is a Junior at Dartmouth High School. Her adventure with CBC began as a 6th grader through Our Sisters' School. Summer enjoys sailing and all of the life lessons learned on the water. Summer helped run classes as an Instructor Apprentice this past season. Summer also set the CBC record for longest distance sailed single handed in a PICO.

Last year, he volunteered during CBC's Sailing into Knowledge program, assisting with the student's remote learning needs. Tyler helped develop and deliver STEM Programming for the Summer Program. During the mornings and at lunch, Tyler ran science activities for the participants to experience, including species identification with seine nets, plankton tows, touch tanks, convection experiments, surface tension exploration with bubbles, adventures in density, and observing fun chemical reactions.

"Tyler. He is very enthusiastic about the environment and has the kids fully engaged in whatever activities he has prepared for them. Both the children and the staff enjoy them, are interested in them, and learn a lot from them. Tyler is always working to improve his activities so that they become even more engaging and expose the kids to new parts of the environment around them."

Blue Lane Rentals

In 2021 CBC launched Blue Lane Rentals in partnership with the City of New Bedford. The City's Department of Parks, Recreation and Beaches had been working for several years to bring new recreational amenities to New Bedford's two public beaches. Blue Lane Rentals operates out of the restored West Beach Boathouse on West Rodney French Boulevard and offers kayak and stand up paddleboard rentals. The program is designed to ensure all residents have access to the new resource, with affordable rental rates and an emphasis on safety for kayaks and paddleboards.



"When I joined this program I learned so much and became better at understanding who I am no matter what people tell me. As a person with ADHD many people would pick on me or tease me for not being normal but in this program I felt accepted and comfortable to be myself. CBC has done so much for me I personally feel like they don't need to do anything because they have already done so much."
