DEAR FRIENDS,

2023 marks a significant milestone for CBC - our 25th anniversary! In 1995, a New Bedford social worker had a vision. After visiting seven young children, JoAnn Tschaen began searching for a way to give them new opportunities and chances to grow and learn. That evening on her way home across the Fairhaven Bridge, seven small boats caught her eye. Seven kids, seven boats... and CBC was born and incorporated as a 501(c)3 in 1998.

Fast forward to 2023 and we have grown well beyond our initial Summer Youth Sailing Program. The 5 boats we started with have grown to 100 and the number of youth we serve has increased from 80 in our early years to over 2000 today. We run year-round programs both in and out of school. And none of this could be achieved without the support we receive from our donors, volunteers, families and partners.

We are extremely proud to report that in 2023, 86% of the kids in our summer programming received the necessary financial support to attend CBC. 86%! That incredible support could not have been achieved without our supporters. THANK YOU! The impact made has been immeasurable and will continue to benefit the kids and our community for years to come.

As we celebrate our 25th anniversary, we reflect on the incredible foundation for programming that spreads CBC's magic throughout so many of greater New Bedford's public and charter schools and many more organizations working with the youth of greater New Bedford. We are honored to continue to be partners with these organizations and this community. We continue to remain committed to improving our curriculum, programming and partnerships, to ensure we are best serving the needs of our community.





EDUCATION

CBC's vision is to engage local area youth in learning positive and practical life skills that will allow them to steer toward a successful future, in college, the workforce or as leaders in their community. Nicole Williams joined our staff in 2023 as an Education Specialist with her initial focus on ensuring that all programming is aligned with the next generation science standards/Massachusetts State standards and expectations.



SEA LAB

In the 2023–2024 school year, we redesigned our Sea Lab program—our largest and most impactful Ocean Stewardship Program—in collaboration with New Bedford Public Schools. Through this initiative, we connect with nearly every fifth-grade student across the district, reaching all NBPS elementary schools. In the 2022–2023 school year alone, we engaged 862 students through this vital program.

During the 2022-2023 school year, Sea Lab Program students were asked at the beginning of class “How many feel they are Ocean Stewards?” Then students would learn about currents and gyres and how the trash we throw away ends up in the ocean. At the end of class students were asked “How many are motivated to become Ocean Stewards?” On average we saw about a 50% increase in students who were motivated to become an ocean steward and want to help protect our ocean.

SALT - SAILING AND LEADERSHIP TRAINING PROGRAM

CBC's workforce development initiative, formerly known as the Junior Instructor Program, is now called the Sailing and Leadership Training (SALT) Program. Started in 2015 in response to the economic challenges facing New Bedford, the SALT Program has grown into a dynamic junior leadership program that mentors students and encourages healthy, constructive interests. The program prepares young leaders with the skills, confidence, and leadership abilities they need to succeed and make a positive impact in their community. Most of the staff in CBC's summer youth sailing program are participants in our SALT Program. Guided by CBC's senior staff, these Junior Instructors (JIs) strengthen their abilities to teach, lead and inspire—becoming inspiring role models and helping extend CBC's influence throughout the community by being the bridge to the next generation. In 2023, we proudly had 70 youth in the program, including 30 who were paid instructors.



The SALT Program leverages the sailing instructor role by pairing it with a curriculum designed to develop these seven essential skills necessary for career and personal success:

Professionalism/Work Readiness, Problem Solving & Critical Thinking, Thriving, Networking/Mentorship, Teamwork, Communication and Leading

Students can join the program the summer before they enter 8th grade and many stay working at CBC after they graduate from high school.


Manta (Natalie)

Spout (Alani)




Spout has the ability to materialize water! Allowing her to help keep our oceans clean and provide safe drinking water for all.

SUMMER YOUTH SAILING PROGRAM

CBC's flagship program, Summer Youth Sailing, is designed to instill positive life values, such as trust, integrity, sound judgment and teamwork. The program is accessible to all regardless of means. 86% of participants in 2023 received financial aid support.



We limit the number of full-pay spots in our regular sailing program each week, reserving the majority of spots for kids who receive financial aid.



SUMMER PROGRAMMING:

SUMMER YOUTH SAILING (AGES 7-17)

This program is for students who are both new to sailing and those who have a few summers of sailing experience. The goals are to have fun on the water and to learn and/or build upon the basics of sailing. Students have the opportunity to sail with an instructor and small group or to sail in their own boat with an instructor-driven safety boat alongside.

WINDSURFING (AGES 9-17)

This program is for anyone looking to learn how to windsurf. CBC has a wide variety of windsurf rigs to accommodate people of all sizes. You can't be too big or too small!!

SEA SQUIRTS (AGES 5-6)

Sea Squirts focuses on creating a comfortable environment with the main goals being water safety and having fun! We mix sailing, games and swimming to help our Sea Squirts build confidence in and around the water. Since 2020, this program has a literacy element using Dr. Seuss books. Each day the staff read one book to the children.

ADVENTURE SAILING (AGES 10-17)

Adventure Sailing is for students who are looking for a fun and exciting way to explore their local environment while receiving individual attention and guidance from their instructors. Students take part in destination sails and excursions. This program takes place at our satellite location at Ft. Taber in New Bedford and is offered to various community partners.

OFFSHORE

Started in 2022, this program builds on the success of existing learn-to-sail and instructor training programs at CBC. It ties into the CBC goal of developing capable, hard-working, personable young adults, who are also ocean stewards. In late spring, students who have shown an interest are invited to come and practice after school, completing short sails on the 33' Beneteau Figaro 2s. (These boats are owned by the Collegiate OffShore Sailing Circuit (COSC) and are rented to CBC.)

This training will hopefully allow some of the students to become watch leaders during the summer. Experienced college sailors are also invited to participate as mentors. The core program takes place in the summer, on two boats for 5-6 weeks in June and July, with a select team expected to continue some training all summer. Every Junior Instructor spends one week in the program to have the experience. Those who take to it join the team and begin team building and skills training. They need to complete US Sailing Online Offshore Safety at Sea to gain certification. A core group of eight sailors has been identified to compete in overnight races and trips. Past races include the Ida Lewis and Whalers' Races.

For 2023 the offshore program had 31 days sailing in July & August with 20+ core crew & 20+ SALT students.
