## EDUCATION

CBC's vision is to engage local area youth in learning positive and practical life skills that will allow them to steer toward a successful future, in college, the workforce or as leaders in their community. CBC's long-term vision is to reach all students in the New Bedford school system at least once during their K-12 years. During the Fall, Winter, and Spring, we partnered with many greater New Bedford organizations to offer STEM education and enrichment opportunities centered around the marine environment for local youth, such as: boat building, ocean stewardship, STEM education and a Marine Trades Training Program.



## SPRING, FALL AND WINTER PROGRAMMING

During the Spring, Fall and Winter we partner with Greater New Bedford Public Schools and many other schools and organizations in our area to offer enrichment opportunities for youth centered around STEM education and the marine environment. These programs began in 2013 when CBC realized there was a tremendous opportunity to play a larger role in the community, particularly in the education process.



## SEA LAB

CBC has been affiliated with the Sea Lab program for the last twenty years. In 2022, we began teaching an ocean stewardship lesson at Sea Lab where students learn about earth science, boat construction and hydrodynamics. From October to June, every 5th grader in NBPS attends CBC's session on Ocean Stewardship. In 2022 we reached 860 students through our Sea Lab programming.

## WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

Started in 2015 in response to the economic challenges youth in the city of New Bedford face, our workforce youth development program provides jobs and training to youth aged 14-24. CBC's goal is to mentor all youth from the first time they enter a program until they graduate high school and beyond. Studies have shown that youth with mentors are more likely to graduate from high school, participate in extracurricular activities, and become civically engaged. Our JI's become part of our family. 65 youth participated in 2022.

## SUMMER PROGRAMMING

WE COLLECTED ALMOST 300 SURVEYS FROM THIS SUMMER'S ATTENDEES



98%

felt their time here had improved their ability to communicate with others and work well in team situations.



97%

felt it had improved their ability to work hard to achieve goals and to solve problems effectively and efficiently.



93%

felt it had improved their ability to resolve conflicts with others effectively.

Our summer program is open to any child, ages 5-17. We offered 8 one-week sessions at our Padanaram Avenue site, plus 4 one-week sessions at our satellite site at Fort Taber for a total of 468 youth served.

The program is accessible to all regardless of means. While the majority of our students come from New Bedford, we have participants from many surrounding towns, and even beyond, particularly during the summer when they are visiting family locally. In 2022, 81% of students received financial aid. Each time CBC students step into a boat they are learning a meaningful lesson. Sailing encourages individuals to come together as a team and collectively overcome challenges. CBC's Summer Youth Sailing program is designed to instill positive life values, such as trust, integrity, sound judgment, and teamwork.



### SEA SQUIRTS

5-6 year olds. This program gets them comfortable and familiar with the water. Each day, the kids were read a Dr. Seuss book and then had a lesson for the day based on the messaging from the book.

### WINDSURFING

9-17 year olds. This was the third year of this program and is for anyone wanting to learn how to windsurf. For the second time in 2022 kids in our windsurf program traveled to 3 events.

### SUMMER YOUTH SAILING

7-17 year olds. This program is for someone new to sailing or who has had a few years of sailing experience. For the first time since 2019 (due to the pandemic), we operated a summer program at the Stucco Building, our satellite location at Fort Taber. Organizations served there included Parker Elementary, Kennedy Summer Day Program and Anchor Academy.

### YOUTH OFFSHORE

We introduced this multi-year program in 2022, building on the success of existing "learn-to-sail" and instructor training programs at CBC. This is a next-level overnight program for young adults aimed to create positive, constructive, mentorship relationships and expand the skill-set of participants. It ties in to the CBC goal of developing capable, hard-working, personable young adults. It also ties into the Ocean Stewardship work that CBC has been doing for years, and should be a point of pride for the regional marine industries. We had many JI's participate in their first overnight races, including the Whaler's Race and the Salty 100. Throughout our summer sailing program, a group of Junior Instructors trained on the boats, each week, for 3 days in and around Buzzards Bay.

## JUNIOR INSTRUCTOR AWARDS

**KINSHIP AWARD** The Kinship Award is presented annually to an individual(s) who has made an outstanding contribution to CBC and exemplifies excellent sportsmanship as set forth by the Directors of the CBC. This perpetual trophy will commemorate Tom Selldorff, the yacht "Kinship" and "Clyde the Hippo". As a lifelong sailor, Tom has shared his passion for sailing with the youth community of New Bedford who might not otherwise have the opportunity to learn and enjoy this sport. The Kinship award will allow children to learn important values and, like Tom, inspire a lifelong love of the ocean.
